Shortening	6 1/2 oz	1 cup	13 oz	2 cups	<p><b>3.</b> Add shortening and liquid mixture to dry ingredients. Blend for 30 seconds on low speed. Beat for 6 minutes on medium speed.</p>

†Raisins, plumped (optional)	8 oz	1 1/4 cups	1 lb	2 1/2 cups	<p><b>4.</b> Add applesauce. Blend for 30 seconds on low speed. Beat for 3 minutes on medium speed. Add raisins (optional) and nuts (optional). Blend 1 minute on low speed.</p> <p><b>5.</b> Into each pan (9" x 13" x 2") which has been lightly coated with pan release spray and dusted with flour, pour 3 lb 12 oz (1 qt 3 1/2 cups) batter. For 25 servings, use 1 pan. For 50 servings, use 2 pans.</p> <p><b>6.</b> Bake until lightly browned: Conventional oven: 375° F for 35 minutes Convection oven: 325° F for 25 minutes</p> <p><b>7.</b> Cool. If desired, dust lightly with powdered sugar.</p> <p><b>8.</b> Cut each pan 5 x 5 (25 pieces). Portion is 1 piece.</p>
